What type of information we have

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Personal identifiers, contacts and characteristics (for example, name and contact details)
- Areas of interest in our organisation
- Web user stats

How we get the information and why we have it

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- You have contacted us directly from a web form, by email or by phone to find out about our company and the services it provides
- We also receive personal information indirectly, from the following sources in the following scenarios:
 - We may have been provided your information by a third party who has advised that you may be interested in finding our more information about our company
 - We may have contacted you directly using information available in the public domain

- (b) We have a contractual obligation.
- (c) We have a legal obligation.
- (d) We have a vital interest.
- (e) We need it to perform a public task.
- (f) We have a legitimate interest.

What we do with the information we have

We use the information that you have given us in order to:

- Contact you with relevant information about Heritage Lab CIC
- Contact you to ask for your help
- Contact you with information from our partners
- Keep you informed of fundraising opportunities
- Keep you informed about research
- Aggregate data to help provide insights for Heritage Lab

We may share this information with relevant bodies working with or for Heritage Lab CIC

How we store your information

Your information is securely stored at Heritage Lab CIC

We keep all your personal data for 7 years. We will then contact you about retaining this information if it is still appropriate or dispose your information by deleting the information from the dataset.

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.





Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to rectify information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your information in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.

Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.
